NEW ASSIGNMENT

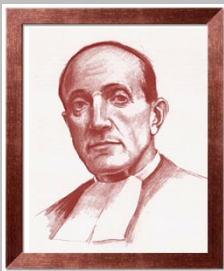

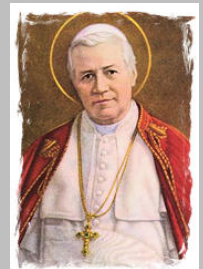
