**Br. Rolando Dizon FSC • 1944 – 2012.** Br. Roly Dizon passed away 25 April 2012 at the age of 67 after battling with cancer. He was President of several Lasallian institutions in the Philippines including De La Salle University and University of St. La Salle. His involvements included socio – civic organizations like the National Movement for Free Elections (NAMFREL) which he chaired in 1986 and which was instrumental in toppling the Marcos Dictatorship.

His wake was held at the National Shrine of the Divine Child in the former Provincialate in Manila from the 26<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup>. After the funeral mass on the 29<sup>th</sup> his remains were cremated and brought to the Memorial Cloister in the Novitiate.
