ANOTHER SET OF TOP AND WORLD-BEATING IBDP 2023 RESULTS

MALAYSIA - St. Joseph's Institution International School Malaysia had another strong set of results this year, and are incredibly proud of its class of 2023. Overall, this cohort has done extremely well. The IBDP promised that the grade distribution would "return to pre-pandemic standards," and so we expected a decrease to the scores we saw in 2020-2022 when provisions were put in place for COVID.

We are pleased to say that our school average has actually increased from 2022 and rests at nearly 38 points, even as the global average has decreased by 1.7% at 30 points this year.

Key statistics arising from these results are:

- A perfect score of 45 points, and two students earning 44 points
- 38 points average score (compared to global average of 30.24 points)
- 6.02 average points per subject (compared to global average of 4.8)
- 32% earning 40 points or above (same as last year)

As they prepare to embark on the next exciting chapter of their lives, we are delighted to share that our Class of 2023 has received offers from prestigious universities across the world such as Imperial College London, University College London, University of California Berkeley, The University of Hong Kong, University of Manchester, University of Toronto, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, The London School of Economics, University of Bristol, The University of Warwick, Newcastle University, Lancaster University, University of Exeter, Cardiff University, University of Bath, and many others. 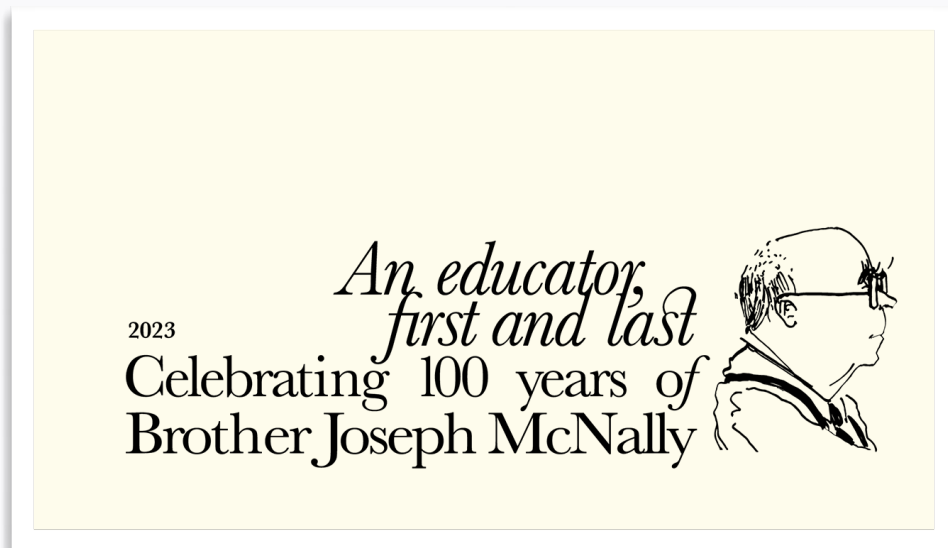


PRESENTATION OF THE LETTER OF AFFILIATION TO AMB. JOSE L. CUISIA JR.
